1. Describe biblical evidence that Professor Dawkins could refer to, that he could use to illustrate his definition of God. [6 marks]
2. In your own words, although with reference to the text, explain Professor Ward's definition of God. [7 marks]
3. "Professor Ward's understanding of God is much more accurate than that of Professor Dawkins". Do you agree? Give reasons for your answer. [7 marks]

SECTION B – WRITE TWO ESSAYS [10 marks each]

Choose 2 questions from the following choice of 4:

1. Religious Texts

Explain why you think Jesus performed miracles. You should refer to two examples in your answer. [10 marks]

2. Religion in the modern world

“Religion does more harm than good”. Do you agree? Give reasons for your answer, showing you have considered more than one point of view. [10 marks]

3. Worship

With reference to a religion you have studied, describe and explain what happens during one of their major festivals (for example, Easter, Yom Kippur, Eid, Diwali, or any other).

4. Ethics

‘Capital punishment has no place in a civilized society’ Do you agree? Give reasons for your answer, showing you have considered more than one point of view. [10 marks]
