Choose one of the following two scenarios.

SCENARIO 1: Society

Recently you spent the summer in Italy and you stayed with an Italian family. You have been asked to write about your experience, in **Italian**, for the language section of your school/college website.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- where exactly you went **and** how you travelled
- what you thought of the family home/house
- what you ate during your stay with the Italian family
- how you got on with the family members
- an outing or trip you went on
- if you would recommend an experience abroad to others.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.

SCENARIO 2: Culture

While on holiday in Italy recently, you went to an Italian food festival. On your return you were asked to write an account of your experience, in **Italian**, for your school/college website.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- where the festival was **and** who you went with
- what you thought of the food you tried/tasted at the festival
- any entertainment/activities that were on during the festival
- the opportunities you had to speak Italian during your visit to Italy
- what you thought of the people you met
- whether you would recommend this kind of experience to others.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.
