Choose **one** of the following two scenarios.

**SCENARIO 1: Society**

Your Italian friend invited you to spend two weeks with his/her family. During your stay the family celebrated your friend's birthday. On your return, you are asked to write a short report in **Italian** about your visit for your school/college website.

**You must include** the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- where you went **and** how you travelled
- how you got on with your friend's family
- what you did to celebrate your friend's birthday
- any day trips you did during your visit to Italy
- opportunities you had to speak Italian
- what you intend to do when your Italian friend visits Scotland next year.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.

OR

**SCENARIO 2: Employability**

Last year you spent three weeks working in a restaurant in Italy. The local newspaper in Italy has asked you to write about your experience in **Italian**.

**You must include** the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- where the restaurant was located **and** what you thought about it
- your working hours at the restaurant
- how you got on with your colleagues
- what you liked/disliked about working with the public
- what you did in your free time
- whether or not you would like to work in another country in the future.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.
